Schools on Dirt Notice of Responsibility for Trip Organizers

As an organizer, you play a crucial role in bringing students to Whistler Blackcomb for a mountain experience. There are a few points we ask you to consider as you prepare to organize your trip.

1. Make students aware that mountain biking involves inherent risks. Injury can be a common occurrence. All students must have ridden a bike and be confident doing so on a flat surface to take part in the program. Please make sure that students and their parents have **read and signed** both the lift ticket and rental waiver before their trip day.
2. Deliver the signed waivers to Whistler Blackcomb upon arrival. Any student without both signed waivers **will not** be permitted to participate in the program.
3. All information on the rental sheet must be as accurate as possible in order for the mountain bike to be adjusted appropriately and efficiently.
4. Use the trip sheet supplied (available online) to email your rental information at least 2 weeks prior to your trip. Email any changes on the same set of forms 3 days prior to your trip. These will be the forms we use when processing your trip and adjusting bikes. Please send all information to wbschools@whistlerblackcomb.com.
5. Organize students outside of the Whistler Gondola rental shop to distribute lift tickets and lunch vouchers. All students must be in possession of a lift ticket in order to access the Whistler Mountain Bike Park.
6. Ensure that all students not renting bikes are outfitted with all the appropriate safety equipment: gloves, arm and leg armour, and a full-face helmet.
7. One trip organizer must be available by cell phone in case a Whistler Blackcomb representative needs to reach them.
8. Bring a support vehicle in the unfortunate circumstance of an accident so that all students are not required to wait if an injured student needs to stay at the medical clinic past your scheduled departure time.
9. Have enough chaperones available to ensure sufficient supervision of any students who, for whatever reason, are unable to ride with their group for the full day.
10. Should you cancel within 72 hours of your arrival date, a cancellation fee will be charged to your school.
11. Provide payment for your Schools on Dirt session prior to leaving Whistler Blackcomb.
