



VACCINATION POLICY FOR COVID-19

At Blackcomb Helicopters, the continued health and safety of our employees, clients and community remain our primary concerns. We continue to take COVID-19 seriously and are adapting our policies and operations to protect our health and economy. These policies have been reviewed by medical experts and align with federal and provincial regulations. As these health and safety regulations evolve, so will our policies.

Vaccination Requirements

- As of Nov 30, all employees and passengers on board Blackcomb Helicopters flights will be vaccinated.
- During the booking process, Guests will need to confirm that they are fully vaccinated.
- Proof of Vaccination and a valid photo identification both bearing the same name will be verified at the time of departure.

Exceptions

- Children under the age of 12 do not currently require vaccination.
- Passengers on board “essential service” flights may be exempt from this policy based on the nature of the flight. This will be determined by Blackcomb Helicopters at the time of the flight

Essential Service Flights may include but not limited to:

- *Flights to service critical infrastructure*
- *Medevac*
- *Search and Rescue*
- *Police Services*
