## ***A Fundraiser for Families Fighting Cancer***

Get Up There started as a public awareness movement, fundraiser and event in BC (and Nova Scotia) for Colorectal Cancer. The mission was to raise the awareness for the prevention of the disease and reduce the stigma associated with colorectal screening. Since 2017, GUT changed the fundraising focus and joined forces with Families Fighting Cancer in the Sea to Sky corridor – keeping funds raised in our community, helping those closest to us who are in need.

Participation in this event gives you your chance to experience the mountain in a very unique way – by climbing over 5000 vertical feet from the Valley to the Peak. Grab a pledge form and hit up your friends and co-workers to support you in your efforts. Participants are required to come with their own equipment. Skis with skins best, snowshoes are OK. Lift tickets are not included.

**Place:** A special uphill route will be marked on Blackcomb Mountain.

**Price:** Each individual is encouraged to raise at least \$200. A minimum donation of \$50 is required to get your bib and access to the uphill trail.  
Valid RFID Lift ticket required – **a complimentary Single Ride ticket will be available to pre-registered participants only (see below).**
