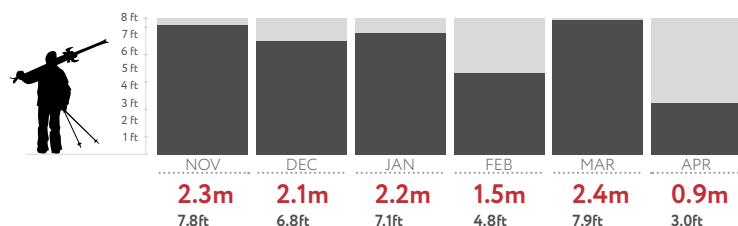

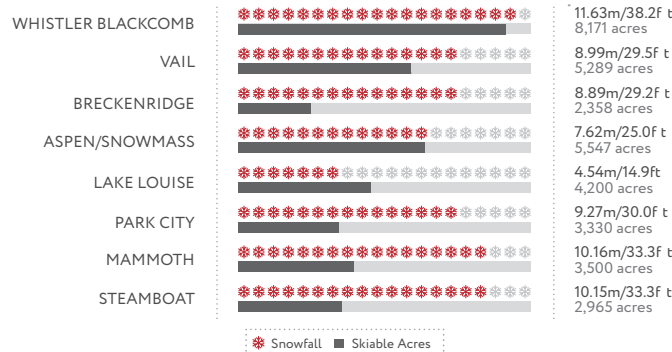

WHISTLER VALLEY

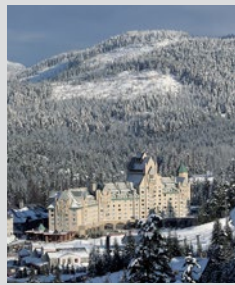

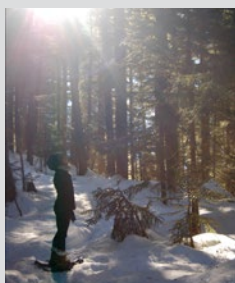
ZIPTREK

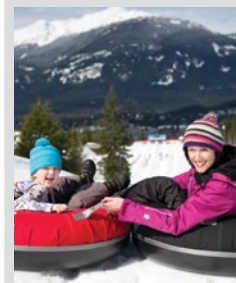
SNOWMOBILE

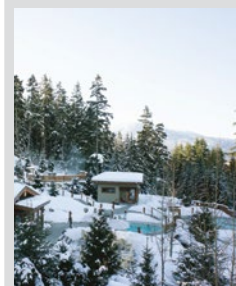
SNOWSHOE

This isn't the tobogganing you remember from your childhood. More like multi-lane, high speed extreme tubing that just may be one of the best memories of your time here.



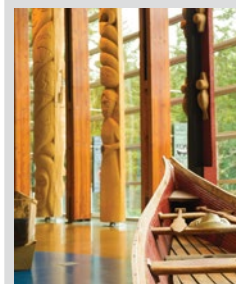

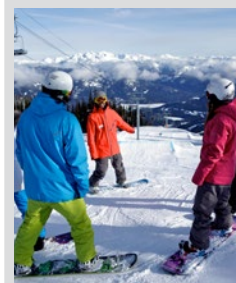
DINING TOURS – WHISTLER TASTING TOURS
