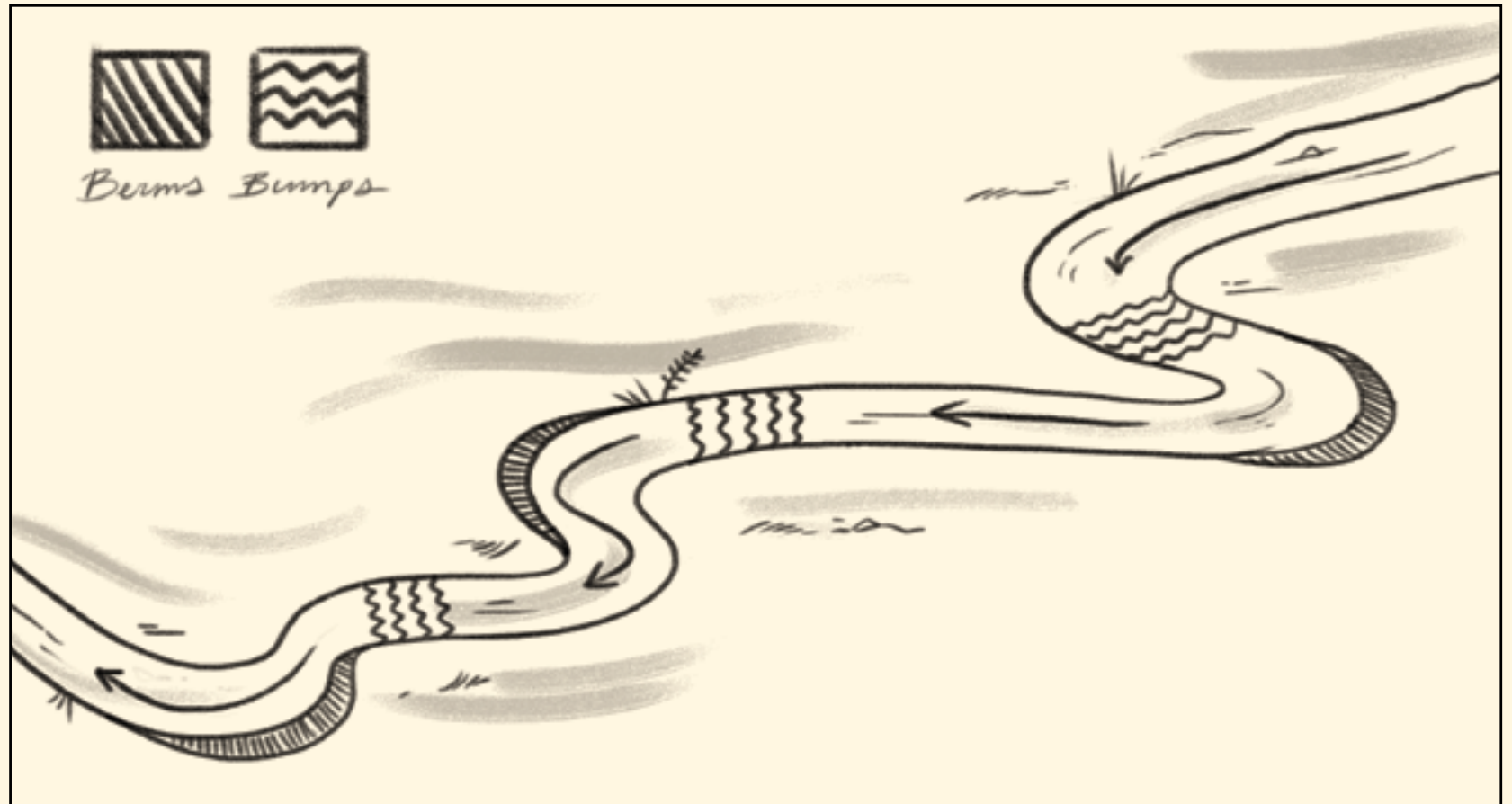

1 - The process of replanting and rebuilding the soil of disturbed land.

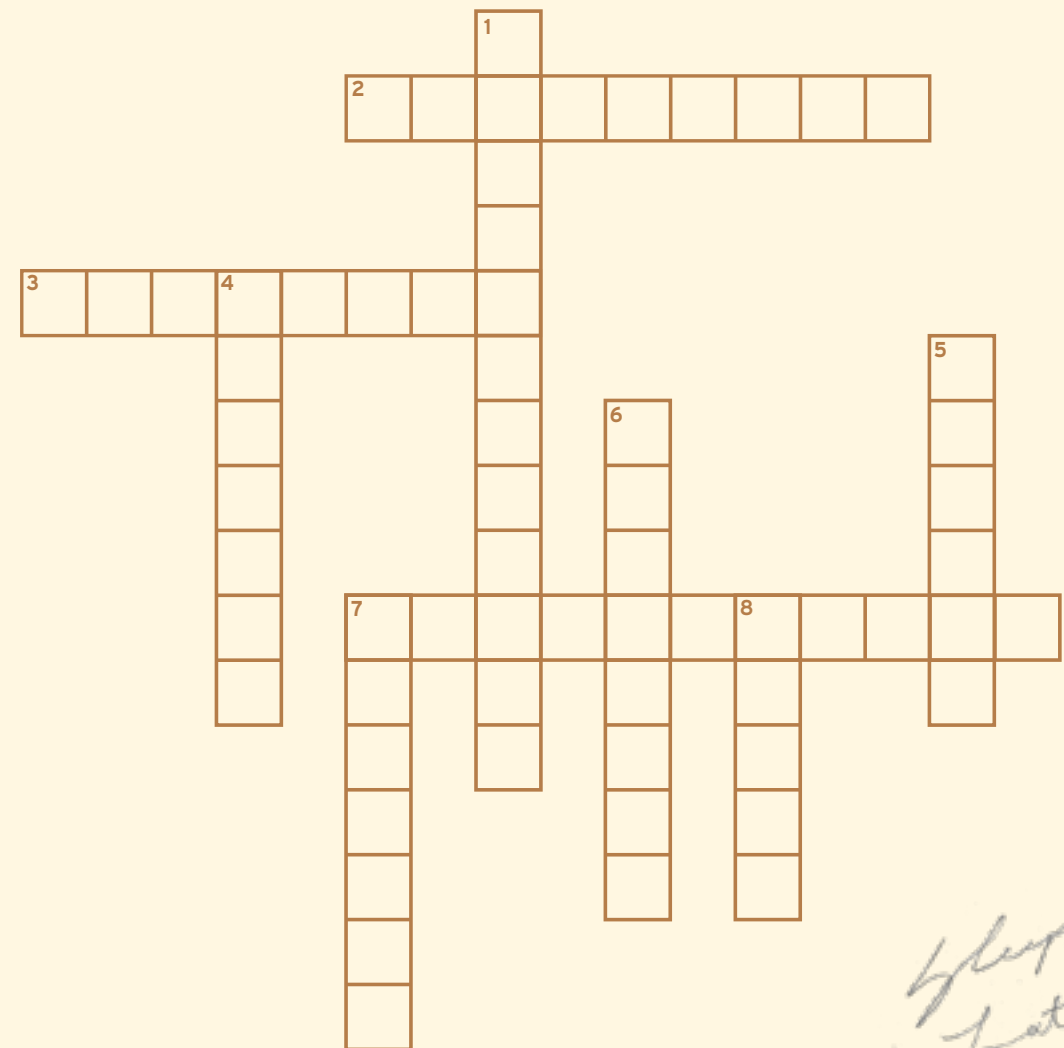
4 - The force that attracts a body toward the center of the earth, or toward any other physical body having mass.

6 - The result of cutting a section of tread across the side of a hill.

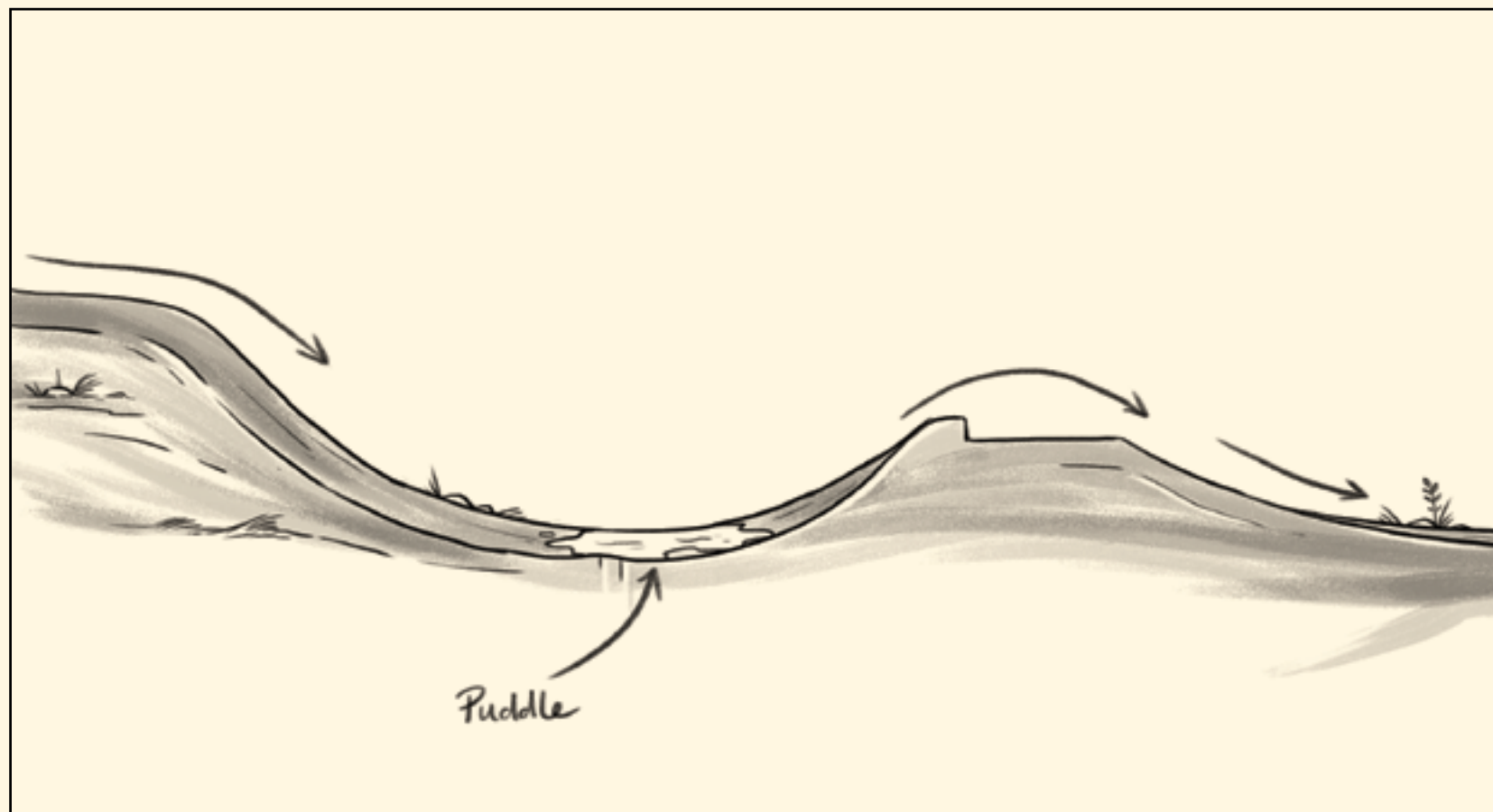
7 - A system in place for identification, warning, or direction.
